#### **ARTISTS' REGISTRATION MEETING JANUARY 23, 2017**

The **registration meeting** for all artist-participants is scheduled for January 23, 2017, at 1PM, and will be held in the OC Fine Arts Room. You or a representative must attend, and your registration forms and entry fee must be completed and turned in at this meeting, **unless you have previously turned in your Registration Form at the January 17 Painters Club meeting**. If you cannot attend, please arrange for someone to attend and turn in your registration forms and entry fee for you. This will also be an opportunity to pass along additional information, clarify instructions, and answer any questions. Postcards will be available at this time.

#### NOTE: You do not have to be a Painters Club member to participate in this show.

#### SHOW HOURS

This year the show will begin on Friday evening, February 24, from 5:30 PM to 8 PM, with a no-host bar. <u>This evening event is open to everyone, not just the artists, so be sure to invite your friends.</u> The show will continue on Saturday, February 25, from 9 AM to 5 PM, and on Sunday, February 26, from 9 AM to 3 PM.

#### POSTCARDS

Postcards will be printed illustrating the show's Signature Art on one side, and information about the show with dates and times on the reverse. You are encouraged to mail these to your friends/clients inviting them to the show on Friday, February 24, from 5:30 PM to 8 PM; Saturday, February 25, from 9 AM to 5 PM; and Sunday, February 26, from 9 AM to 3 PM. These quality postcards will be distributed at the Painters Club January 17 meeting and at the January 23 registration/information meeting.

#### DELIVERY OF ARTWORK

Art must be delivered to the Orchard Creek Ballroom on Friday, February 24, from 11:30 AM to 12:30. This is the ONLY time that work can be accepted. The receiving area will be located in the hallway on the south side of the ballroom. The registration area may be busy; please be patient.

Unsold Art <u>must</u> be picked up at the close of show promptly at 3:00 PM on Sunday, February 26. <u>We</u> cannot be responsible for work remaining after 3:00 PM.

#### LINCOLN HILLS FINE ARTS SHOW Rules for Entry

- 1. The Registration Form and Entry Fee will be accepted at the January 17 Painters Club meeting or at the Registration Meeting on January 23. If you are unable to attend, please arrange for someone to attend for you. Due to space restrictions, *entries shall be limited to 60 artists*.
- 2. NO ENTRIES OR CHANGES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER JANUARY 23, NOR CAN PRICES BE CHANGED OR LOWERED DURING THE SALE.
- 3. Entrants must be residents of Sun City Lincoln Hills but do not have to be Painters Club members.
- 4. Each artist may enter a maximum of 4 pieces of two-dimensional or three-dimensional art. If a piece is sold, it may be replaced for a \$10 restocking fee. Minimum sale price for artwork is \$100. Only one piece may be designated NFS (not for sale).
- 5. Work must be original, not previously shown in the Fine Arts Show. No copies, no crafts, or works by commercial printing process (i.e., no giclees, enhanced giclees, or prints of original artwork). Exception: Photography will be accepted. Fine arts sculpture and wood turning will be accepted. All entries must be dry. The Fine Arts Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry that is deemed inappropriate to the purpose and goals of the show.
- 6. The registration fee for entering the art show is \$35.
- 7. Paintings must be framed or on wrap-around canvas. Any exception must be reviewed by the Rules Committee.
- 8. Two-dimensional work must be ready for hanging. No sawtooth or eyelet hangers. D-rings (flat hangers) and wire are available at local home and/or hardware stores.
- 9. Three-dimensional art must be decorative only, not for food use, and suitable for display on tables or pedestals.

### 10. Attached are two-part labels. Complete the label and affix the upper half of the label to the upper left-hand corner of the back of each painting or photograph. Retain the lower half as your receipt for pickup.

- 11. 15% of each sale will be deducted from the total sale price to cover administrative charges. Sales tax will be added at point of sale. Artists will receive their checks approximately three weeks following the show. All sales must be made through the FASC at the show's front desk.
- 12. Artwork must be received in the Ballroom on Friday, February 24, between 11:30 AM and 12:30 PM. The show will open to the public starting at 5:30 PM on that evening.
- 13. The show will be juried by David Peterson of Sacramento Fine arts, and prizes will be awarded. The first place prize-winning artist will not be eligible for prizes for the following three years.
- 14. <u>Only Set-up Committee members will be allowed in the Ballroom during hanging and preparation for the show.</u> Unauthorized personnel will be asked to leave.
- 15. No awards, biographies, or books may be displayed with artwork. Standard sized business cards may be displayed. You may display your biography/artist statement on one 8.5 x 11 sheet, which will be placed in a three-ring binder at the front desk during the show.
- 16. Artists are required to attend 2 hours each day.
- 17. On Sunday, February 26, unsold artwork must be picked up at 3:00 PM in the ballroom. Kindly present your receipts. If someone will be collecting your work, they must have a signed permission statement and your receipt.
